Eligible Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must have a current IEP • exhibits severe and pervasive delays in all areas of conceptual, linguistic, and academic development as well as in adaptive behaviors, including communication, daily living skills, and self-care • following a course of study that, upon completion of high school, may not lead to admission into a college-level course of study resulting in a college degree • is not receiving instruction in the North Carolina Extended Common Core and Essential Standards <p>meets the criteria above <u>AND</u> has a written parental request for an alternate assessment</p>	
Testing Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>150 minutes</u> (not including time for general instructions and breaks) • must be administered in one school day • the tests must be administered in a specific order (i.e., English, math, reading and science) <p>students must not stop when they complete the questions for a subject area section; students must continue working on the test questions until the test is completed or until time is called</p>	
Question Types	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>English</i> = 14 Multiple Choice • <i>Math</i> = 12 Multiple Choice • <i>Reading</i> = 6 Multiple Choice • <i>Science</i> = 11 Multiple Choice • <i>Writing</i> = N/A <p>Total = 43 questions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>English</i> = 13 Multiple Choice • <i>Math</i> = 12 Multiple Choice • <i>Reading</i> = 8 Multiple Choice • <i>Science</i> = 10 Multiple Choice • <i>Writing</i> = 1 Constructed Response <p>Total = 44 questions</p>
Scoring and Reporting	<p>Students will receive a single score based on how many questions they answer correctly. These scores are not included in the Accountability model for performance, but are included for participation (Grade 11 only).</p>	
Testing Accommodations	<p>The need for accommodations must be documented in the students' current IEPs. Test Administrator Reads Test Aloud may be provided on all sections of the test.</p>	
Calculators	<p>Students must have access to, at minimum, a four-function calculator with memory key during the math portion of the assessment.</p>
